BoC concept

The new interior design concept of the Bank of China in Luxembourg was inspired by the corporate identity of the bank. The main idea for the interior decoration was the merger of Chinese tradition with European interior design, thus creating an acceptably bright place and – by effective utilisation of the space – an efficient work environment.

The interior of the bank is based on the modern concept of room use and design, which offers the visitor a comfortable feeling and increases the workplace convenience of the bank employees. The design creates a pleasant working atmosphere and combines the element of easy design with that of practical design. The utilisation of the room makes the ambience convenient for the visitor. The draft of the bank considers the utilisation of public space, with the aim of a spacious and visitor-friendly design.

The design of doors, furniture, floors and ceilings creates a luxurious and elegant atmosphere. The usage of exotic woods and indirect illumination has the effect of natural light and at the same time creates a hospitable ambience for the customer.
