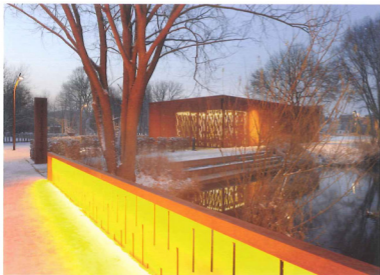

# Luxembourg



When the commune of Kayl-Tetange wished to build a new restaurant for its inhabitants together with a special visitor attraction, the services of WW+ architects were enlisted. The resulting restaurant 'Pavillon Madeleine' and the newly designed 'Park Ouerbett' form a new centre for the community. Located in the south of the grand duchy of Luxembourg, close by the industrial quarter at Esch-sur-Alzette, they attract people from all around to visit the park and dine there.

The 40-seat restaurant is designed to fit harmoniously within the structure of the park. Great importance has been placed on the materiality and function of the façade. By using steel, the cultural heritage of the steel industry in Luxembourg is enforced. It also protects the restaurant from vandalism and, as

steel is also used in the park's design elements, helps to create a strong connection between the two.

An open cooking concept developed once the renowned chef Lea Linster became involved in the restaurant. In addition to offering a tantalizing taste experience, Pavillon Madeleine also presents an impressive visual introduction into the artistic preparation of meals. A terrace with barbecue station provides an additional 40 seats and defines the entrance into the restaurant. Unadorned walls contrast with a black steel chimney while the parquet floor and three gold-coloured suspended lamps offer a warm and comfortable atmosphere for dining.
